### **Renowned Sculptor Carl Regutti to Create Centerpiece for Triangle's Amberly Community**

CARY, N.C., May 24, 2006 – Carl Regutti, a Cary, N.C. based sculptor and designer, has been commissioned by GS Carolina, developer of the master-planned Amberly community. Regutti will design a statue that will become the centerpiece for the development's state-of-the-art Residents' Club.

The classic, fine-art bronze statue, entitled "The Essence of Amberly," will combine the four elements of Amberly - environment, wellness, education and technology, while incorporating the classic Greek elements, earth, water, wind and fire.

"We feel Amberly is being developed to provide a quality of life that's never been available in the Triangle area," said Bob Jones, general manager of Amberly and GS Carolina's Raleigh division. "The uniqueness of this community called for a one-of-a-kind element to represent it."

According to Regutti, the sculpture will be a unique piece of artwork that combines abstract and realistic style together, which he refers to as "Regutti Abstracto-Realism." "Amberly already stands alone as a magnificent community, this sculpture will stand for all that makes the community such a special place to live and grow," said Regutti. "The Amberly statue will be a permanent piece of the community, The Essence of Amberly – today, tomorrow and in the future."

Carl Regutti's work is well known nationally and in the Triangle area. One of his most renowned pieces is "Aristides - Winner First Kentucky Derby, 1875" which is a life-size thoroughbred sculpture in historic Churchill Downs Race Track in Louisville, Ky.

Regutti has also developed a reputation for his work on a number of public pieces and memorial statues in the Triangle area, including the recently revealed North Carolina Fallen Firefighter Memorial, located in downtown Raleigh's Nash Square. Regutti also sculpted "The Railroad Man" located outside the Amtrak station in Cary.

The concepts of Regutti's artwork for the Amberly sculpture will be used in other monuments and design throughout the community. The sculpture will be unveiled as part of the Amberly Residents' Center grand opening event scheduled for later this year.
