QUESTION 14 WATER

VOLUSIA COUNTY GROWTH AND RESOURCE MANAGEMENT (LETTER DATED JANUARY 15, 2008)

<u>Question 14, Water, D. 14-1:</u> The applicant's response indicates that a water quality monitoring program and appropriate water quality treatment features will be established in the SMMP. Therefore, the response to this question should be considered insufficient until the SMMP is submitted for review as part of the DRI sufficiency response process.

Located in Appendix 12-1 and the attached CD is the proposed <u>Site Mitigation and Management Plan (SMMP) Executive Summary</u> which includes our proposed water quality monitoring program. Additional information regarding the proposed stormwater management plan (including water quality treatment features) can also be found in Question 19. It should also be noted that the recent St. Johns River Water Management District Consumptive Use Permit issued to the City of Edgewater includes specific conditions regarding water quality monitoring required of the City as part of their planned wellfield expansion on the Restoration project site. The Applicant is also working together with the City of Edgewater on these requirements.
