QUESTION 26 RECREATION AND OPEN SPACE

THE NATURE CONSERVANCY (LETTER DATED JANUARY 15, 2008)

If a golf course is designed into this project, it would be appropriate to utilize the fairways and greens as a buffer to adjoining protected lands, rather than more intense use such as home sites, roads, and other infrastructure.

The Applicant has revised the Master Development Plan (Map H) and removed the planned golf course as a permitted use. Restoration no longer includes a golf course.

Note: The Applicant is including a revised Exhibit 26-1, <u>Conceptual Trails Network</u> to correspond to the new and revised Map H, <u>Master Development Plan</u>.
