THE NATURE CONSERVANCY (LETTER DATED JANUARY 15, 2008)

- **If a golf course is designed into this project, it would be appropriate to utilize the fairways and greens as a buffer to adjoining protected lands, rather than more intense use such as home sites, roads, and other infrastructure.**

The Applicant has revised the Master Development Plan (Map H) and removed the planned golf course as a permitted use. Restoration no longer includes a golf course.

Note: The Applicant is including a revised Exhibit 26-1, Conceptual Trails Network to correspond to the new and revised Map H, Master Development Plan.
